


Adventurer Club



NAD Youth & Young Adult Ministries Committee



On March 21-22, 2022, the first NAD Youth & Young Adult Ministries

Committee was convened at the NAD Headquarters in Columbia, MD. Throughout 2021 this committee was restructured and is being reconstituted for the next four year (2022-2025) under the leadership of Wendy Eberhardt (NAD Vice President for Ministries), Tracy Wood (NAD Youth & Young Adult Ministries Director), Vandeon Griffin (NAD Youth & Young Adult Ministries Associate Director for Youth Ministries), and Armando Miranda Jr (NAD Youth & Young Adult Ministries Associate Director for Club Ministries).

Each of the nine unions of the NAD has representation on this committee. The union youth & young adult directors have all selected two conference youth directors (one for youth min and one for young adult min) to serve with them on this committee. Also, there are several youth pastors and young adult pastors who serve as well.

In addition, there are Members at Large who also serve representing: AdventSource, BAYDA, Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary, and others.

This committee will meet annually in-person with a mid-year online meeting to keep all the actionable items that were approved moving forward.


NAD Young Pastors Network Initiative

Free Online Course: Introduction to Youth Ministry



The **Introduction to Youth Ministry** Certification is designed to develop the skills required to be an effective youth ministries leader. The purpose of this self-study course is to equip local church youth leaders, teen, youth Sabbath School leaders, and parents to work with youth in the local church.

Participants will learn basic leadership and mentoring principles, and the developmental stages of teenagers. They will understand teen challenges, their current culture trends, and their digital world. 


BEFORE THEY VOLUNTEER
